# Anne Adams Helms Discusses "Michael and Anne In Yosemite Valley"

In 1941, when Anne Adams Helms was a small child, her iconic parents—photographer Ansel Adams and business-woman Virginia Best Adams—published a children's storybook about Anne and her older brother. *Michael and Anne in Yosemite Valley* captures the story of Anne and her brother Michael as children as they experience Yosemite Valley, which was literally their front yard, their back yard, their hometown and their neighborhood.

The charming 66-page cloth-bound book (now out of print) features text and photographs by her parents. Ansel Adams was a distinguished photographer and conservationist and Virginia Best Adams operated Best's Studio, known as the Ansel Adams Gallery in Yosemite Valley.

AAUW-MPB—of which Anne is a member—is privileged to hear Anne discuss this cherished book. Anne holds a BA in English from Stanford University and an MA in Anthropology from San Francisco State University. She was an integral part of Museum Graphics, which began as a postcard publishing business and now includes museum-quality reproductions familiar to all of us.
